- 1. Must be able and willing to wear the prescribed Departmental uniform and comply with Departmental Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Must be certified and able to maintain certification as an EMT/AEMT as prescribed by N.Y. State Dept. of Health.
- 3. Must be able to report for work on a daily basis and function efficiently throughout an entire work shift without interruption. Must be able to work rotating shifts, weekends and holidays as assigned.
- 4. Must be able to withstand varied environmental conditions including extreme heat, cold and moisture. Must be able to work in low light conditions and confined spaces.
- 5. Must be able to operate a Police Ambulance both day and night in emergency situations involving speeds in excess of posted limits, in congested traffic and in unsafe road conditions including rain, fog, snow and ice. Candidates must possess and maintain a valid Class "D" N.Y. State Driver's License at the time of application and appointment. Must be able to observe intersecting traffic and maintain control of Police Vehicle.
- 6. Must be able to communicate clearly and effectively in English over police radio and with the general public. Must be able to interpret and follow written and oral diagnostic form instructions. Must be able to clearly testify in court and other formal settings.
- 7. Must be able to make fast, accurate decisions as to patient care, travel routes and vehicle operation.
- 8. Must be able to read and accurately interpret English language manuals and road maps. Must be able to accurately discern street signs and addresses. Must be able to write clearly in English and be able to document all relevant information in the prescribed departmental format.
- 9. Must be able to perform rescue functions at accidents, emergencies and disasters. Must be able to quickly enter and exit an ambulance. Must be able to lift, carry and drag heavy objects. Must be able to evacuate severely injured people from dangerous situations.
- 10. Must be able to bend, stoop and crawl over uneven terrain. Must be able to remain sitting or standing for extended periods of time. Must be able to climb or jump over obstacles, jump down from elevated surfaces, enter confined areas and maintain balance on narrow surfaces.

- 11. Must be able to interview and clearly communicate with patients, family members and bystanders. Must be able to take control of emotionally disturbed individuals whether by use of verbal skills or physical force if necessary.
- 12. Must be able to prepare clear, concise reports of investigations, incidents or accidents utilizing appropriate grammar, Police Terminology, symbols and mathematical computations.

The successful applicant must be able to perform all of the above essential job functions, unassisted and at a pace and level of performance consistent with the actual job performance requirements. This requires a level of physical ability to include vision, hearing, speaking, flexibility and strength.
